Without a functioning Board, the State could require our HOA to be placed under the governance of another HOA. In the event this situation was to occur, we would then as a community be subject to that new HOA's rules, regulations and assessment fees. We believe decisions affecting our community should continue to be made by the people who live here.

Board Responsibilities

Board members work together to:

- Oversee the maintenance and management of our roads, beaches, and mailhouse.
- Coordinate with contractors, vendors, and service providers.
- Address community concerns and assist in resolving issues.
- Make informed decisions that protect and enhance our neighborhood.

Eligibility Requirements

To serve on the Board of Directors, candidates must:

- Be listed on the property deed.
- Be current on all HOA assessments and dues.
- Members with felony convictions may serve only in an At-Large position.
